

## Steps and Time Frame in the Registration Process for Registered Interior Designers

When	What	Time Frame	Cost
Upon graduation from a FIDER-accredited program	Contact NCIDQ to open a record. Begin gaining interior design experience via IDEP or on own.	Varies by candidate – usually two years	IDEP costs set by NCIDQ (currently \$225)
Upon completion of IDEP or other interior design experience	Apply to take NCIDQ Exam. If experience gained through IDEP, NCIDQ will advise that you are qualified to take NCIDQ. If completing experience on own and not through IDEP, contact NCIDQ for exam application.	Varies by candidate	Set by NCIDQ (currently \$695). IDEP participants receive exam discounts, as set by NCIDQ.
Upon complete passage of NCIDQ (if passed prior to October 2000)	Contact NSBAIDRD for an application. You may have to take and pass the Nevada Supplemental Exam for Registered Interior Designers. Advise NCIDQ to transmit your complete record to Nevada board.	Varies by candidate	\$100 exam fee
Upon complete passage of NCIDQ (if passed after October 2000)	Contact NSBAIDRD for an application. Advise NCIDQ to transmit your complete record to Nevada board.	Varies by candidate	
After complete application is submitted	Board staff contacts applicant and sends a “registration quiz.” Applicant completes this open book quiz on statute (NRS 623).	Once quiz is received in board office, applicant will receive results within 10 business days	
Application is complete and quiz is passed.	Become registered by the board	Up to three months – dependent upon time of next scheduled board meeting	\$125 certificate fee \$150 annual registration \$25 stamp fee (\$300 total)
Prior to December 31 of each year	Renew registration	Every calendar year	\$150 annual registration
